Who was Lord Brabazon?

John Moore-Brabazon was born in 1884, just the right time in history to participate in the development of two new forms of transport made possible by the invention of the internal combustion engine.

As a Cambridge student, he had a holiday job working for Charles Rolls. Next he became an apprentice at Darracq in Paris and started racing, winning the 1907 Circuit des Ardennes in a Minerva. Aviation interested him even more and in 1909 he became the first Englishman to make an officially recognized aeroplane flight in Britain. As a leading proponent of motoring and flight, he contributed to my grandfather's magazine The Car Illustrated. He went on to have a remarkable career both as a politician and a sportsman. He excelled at tobogganing and, in 1955, won the Cresta Run Coronation Cup at the age of 71.

His links with my family were revived when my father asked him to become Patron of the Montagu Motor Museum which he opened in 1956. He became my Godfather in 1961 but died just three years later so, sadly, I have no recollection of him. I am delighted, however, that the Brabazon name lives on here in this restaurant.
