

Autojumble Exhibitor and Visitor Safety Promise

Although the government are officially lifting all Covid guidelines and restrictions from the 19th July, we still want to ensure the safety of all that attend our event.

To ensure that the International Autojumble is a safe place for everyone, please take a look at the safety measures we will be implementing:

We will not require proof of vaccination or a negative lateral flow test but we would recommend that you take a lateral flow test within the 48 hours prior to attending the event. Please note, if you have been vaccinated we would still advise you do a LFT as you can still carry Covid.

Other ways to get rapid lateral flow tests

You might be able to:

- collect tests from a pharmacy (in England, Scotland and Wales only)
- collect tests from a community centre, such as a library
- get a test at a site
- Order by phone – call 119. Lines are open 7am to 11pm and calls are free.

If a test result is positive

If you or anyone in your household tests positive:

1. Everyone in the household must [self-isolate](#) immediately.
2. The person who tests positive must [get a PCR test](#) to confirm the result (a PCR test is a different type of COVID-19 test).

You must not attend the event:

- **If you have tested positive for COVID-19** – you must isolate for 10 days in accordance with government isolation requirements.
- **If you have COVID-19 symptoms** – please follow the guidance on testing and self-isolation.

As a reminder, these are the main Covid symptoms you should look out for when taking a Covid test: a high temperature, a new continuous cough, a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste.

- **If you have been instructed to self-isolate.**

Exhibitors Safety Guidance

We recommend exhibitors

- Consider following government advice and wear a face covering in our indoor spaces. This includes the Grand Marquee stands within the Autojumble.

- Consider wearing a face covering in crowded areas. There is plenty of outdoor space at the Autojumble but if a particular area is crowded we recommend wearing a face covering – please consider wearing a face covering on your stand space to protect yourself and others.
- Wash and sanitise your hands regularly. We recommend each stallholder has hand sanitiser readily available on their stall.
- Design your stall layout in a sensible format such as with a one way system in place, putting up screens between yourselves and other customers.
- Follow cleaning and disinfecting practices, including sanitising any stall surfaces and equipment touched by workers and customers.
- Put in place measures that prevent the spread of infection amongst staff, volunteers and customers – i.e. the issuing of PPE.
- Minimise the handling of money.
- Conduct a Covid-19 specific risk assessment as part of your overall exhibitor risk assessment.
- **Please be respectful of other people’s space whilst visiting.**
- Adhere to any relevant COVID-19 safety measures in place at the event, including observing directions given by stewards.

We recommend visitors....

- Consider following government advice and wear a face covering in our indoor spaces. This includes the Grand Marquee stands within the Autojumble.
- Consider wearing a face covering in crowded areas. There is plenty of outdoor space at the Autojumble but if a particular area is crowded we recommend wearing a face covering.
- Wash and sanitise your hands regularly. We will have sanitiser available at key locations around the event but recommend you carry your own.
- Minimise the handling of money – pay by card where possible.
- Only handle the items you intend on purchasing.
- Purchase your visitor tickets in advance – this will minimise transactions on the day and reduce queueing time.
- Please arrive at the stated timeslot on your ticket in order for us to manage arrival capacities on entry.
- **Please be respectful of other people’s space whilst visiting.**
- Adhere to any relevant COVID-19 safety measures in place at the event, including observing directions given by stewards.
- Be patient if you have to queue for our facilities.

If you become unwell whilst at the event.

- If you experience symptoms whilst attending the event, please exit the site as soon as possible whilst maintaining social distance from others.
- If you are unable to leave the event, please report to our first aid point, this is located in red field by the Old Wall area. Please do NOT go to the first aid point in the Brabazon restaurant as this is indoors.
- Please do not touch anything and maintain social distance from others whilst making your way there.

We will...

- Welcome you with a warm hello and smile, albeit from a safe distance.
- Have friendly members of staff onsite to monitor visitor activity and safety around the event.
- Our members of staff will keep a safe distance away from you around the event.
- Provide hand washing and sanitisation stations to help you keep your hands clean.
- Regularly monitor and clean our lavatories and shared spaces.
- Event timings have been altered in order to avoid crowding of visitors prior to the Autojumble opening. Visitors can now access the Automart & Dealermart areas as well as the Beaulieu attraction from opening at 8.30am. The Autojumble will open at 9.30am on Saturday 4 September and 9am on Sunday 5 September.
